February 10 – The Gospel on Every Page

- Objective: Explain and demonstrate how every genre of Scripture across redemptive history points to Christ
- Reading [50 pages plus spiritual gifts test and emotional maturity inventory]
 - *Total Church*: Introduction, Chapters 1-2 (“Why Gospel?” and “Why Community?”)
 - *Community*: Introduction (“Diagnosis” and “Part One”)
 - Additional: Spiritual gifts test and emotional health inventory

February 17 – Brothers and Sisters in the Family of God

- Objective: Communicate and apply a winsome and complementarian description of gender roles in a small group
- Reading [53 pages]
 - *Total Church*:
 - *Community*: Chapter 2 (“Body”)
- Additional: “Through His Apostles, Jesus Christ Taught Gender Equality and Role Differences in the Christian Community” (Strauch) – digital copy provided to participants

February 24 – Applying the Gospel Together

- Objective: Practice applying the gospel from a variety of Scripture passages as part of small group life
- Reading [51 pages]
 - *Total Church*: Chapters 9-11 (“Spirituality,” “Theology,” and “Apologetics”)
 - *Community*: Chapter 1 (“Image”)

March 3 - Gospel Rhythms

- Objective: Contrast the consumeristic and individualistic liturgies of the world with alternatives that reflect gospel priorities
- Reading [63 pages]
 - *Total Church*:
 - *Community*: Chapter 3-4, 7 (“Ownership,” “Community,” and “Rhythms”)

March 10 – Knowing Ourselves and Each Other

- Objective: Lay out a biblical model of emotions and apply to small group relationships
- Reading [33 pages]
 - *Total Church*: Chapter 8 (“Pastoral Care”)
 - *Community*: Chapter 8 (“Structure”)

March 17– Growing in Christ Together

- Objective: Provide practical models for discipleship within a small group
- Reading [41 pages]
 - *Total Church*: Chapter 7 (“Discipleship and Training”), Chapter 12 (“Children and Young People”)
 - *Community*: Chapter 9 (“Repentance”)

March 24– Small Group Evangelism

- Objective: Identify each person's role in a small group's evangelism
- Reading [58 pages]
 - *Total Church*: Chapters 3 (“Evangelism”)
 - *Community*: Chapters 5-6 (“Neighborhood” and “Spaces”)

March 31– Individual Evangelism

- Objective: Learn how to read the Bible with non-Christians and wrap up the Intensive
- Reading [58 pages]
 - *Total Church*: Chapter 4-6 (“Social Involvement,” “Church Planting,” and “World Mission”)
 - *Community*:
